Get to know how local kids live and how their mothers make crafts to support their families. A great way to pick souvenirs for your Friends back home!








### ACOBIA Manatee Rescue Center

- What's the difference between a cute Little frog and one with deadly poison in its skin? Two hints: look for its "blue jeans" and listen to all the survival tips your guide knows!






### Other kid-friendly activities
