By midday, the Yanayacu River invites adventure. Glide silently through the mirrored waters of the Amazon, surrounded by towering trees and the calls of the rainforest.


After dinner, the day closes with a night safari along the Nauta Caño. Under the cover of darkness, caimans, owls, and other nocturnal

creatures emerge, their presence illuminated by starlight and the quiet guidance of your naturalist.







RECOMMENDATIONS: Itineraries may change due to weather or river conditions, with excursions adjusted at the Delfin crew's discretion. Iquitos experiences warm, humid weather with temperatures ranging from 21°C to 33°C (70°F to 90°F). The rainy high-water season runs from January to June, and the dry low-water season from

or wind-resistant jackets for cooler nights; waterproof boots and rain ponchos are provided. To protect against insects, we recommend taking Vitamin B or B-15 before arrival, along with
